

“Ordo Ab Chao: The Masonic Paradigm”

Some modern Christian Churches repeat catechisms and “ritualist” sayings over and over and some even make the new aspirant to Christianity repeat a sort of standard belief statement before they are fully accepted into the congregation.

Over the decades since Pike introduced his system of Freemasonry that has become the Ancient and Accepted Scottish Rite of Freemasonry, the York Rites have slipped in their perceived importance and have taken a back seat to this Scottish stepchild.

The allure of the 33rd Degree of the A. A. S. R. to the common Blue Lodge Mason, has led them panting after the Scottish Rites, as that high Masonic “honor” is seen by many, if not most Blue Lodge Masons, as the highest honor to be awarded in Freemasonry today.

It is very much like the perceived value of diamonds in our world. Diamonds are actually very common and are no longer hard to find, as they once were when they took on their “mystical qualities” and became one of the World currencies between nations

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and peoples of nations. Today, they are only as valuable as the common person puts on them: it is only a perceived value, not a genuine one anymore.

Under direct scrutiny we find that, only fifty years ago, the 33rd Degree was only on a par with the Knights Templar Degree of the York Rites, not above it.

It was seen in the eyes of Masons who were still witnesses to the end of the era of the York Rites and their dominance, that the Christian tenants and principles of the Knights Templar degree were the highest level of Masonic knowledge and honor in any of the degrees of Masonry.

It was, therefore, seen as the equivalent of any “pagan” degree that the Scottish Rites could concoct and the Masons of the day plainly put the Knights Templar degree of the York Rites equal or above the 33rd Degree of the other Rite.

Today, the Christian Knights Templar degree (I knowingly, but mistakenly call the Knights Templar a “degree” when in fact it is known as part of the “Orders” of the Christian Commandery of Freemasonry, and for this I apologize to my Christian Masonic brethren) is seen as “common”, one that anyone can get without trying, simply by petitioning the Commandery for membership.

The 33rd Degree, however, is seen as being harder to get and more “valuable” to the Mason than the Knights Templar is.

The reason is simple: the first three degrees have been folded into the Scottish Rite leadership and they

This is, of course, a parody of the Tolkien theme of the Lord of the Rings, which speaks of the cruel intentions of the maker of the one ring of power.

You the reader may not know that the great allure of the Scottish Rites is the ring that they give you when you go through their Rites of ceremony. You may, in fact, know that there is a ring, as you may have inherited your grandfather’s “ring” and not known what it was.

It is the great Scottish Rite “ring of power” that binds all members together under the banner of the Scottish Rite heresy.

They try to make new members take off their wedding rings and put their Scottish Rite ring on that

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finger, having just “baptized” the ring finger a little while earlier, by asking that you remove your wedding ring and allowing a Scottish Rite leader to immerse your ring finger in pure water to symbolize your purifying by “ablution” to the “right” to wear the ring.

Any student of religious thought knows that this is a common symbol of submission to Deity and is common in Judaism, Islam and Christianity as well: baptism in its many forms and for its many perceived purposes, is common among the three great “religions” of Abraham.

The Scottish Rites use it in mock imitation of those faiths, while denying that they are any part of them, belonging instead to all the “religions” of the World, cults and Christian blasphemies, such as Paganism, Witchcraft, and all others included.

York Rite Freemasonry is the real “diamond” of our Craft, while Scottish Rite Freemasonry is the “cubic zirconium” of the Craft: only true craftsman and artisans of the Ancient Craft Masonry can tell the difference any more.

Very much like diamonds and CZ to the common person, both of them “appearing” to be genuine, it takes skill and knowledge to spot the differences and tell them apart.

So it is with false Freemasonry, like the Scottish Rites, and true Freemasonry, like the York Rites.
